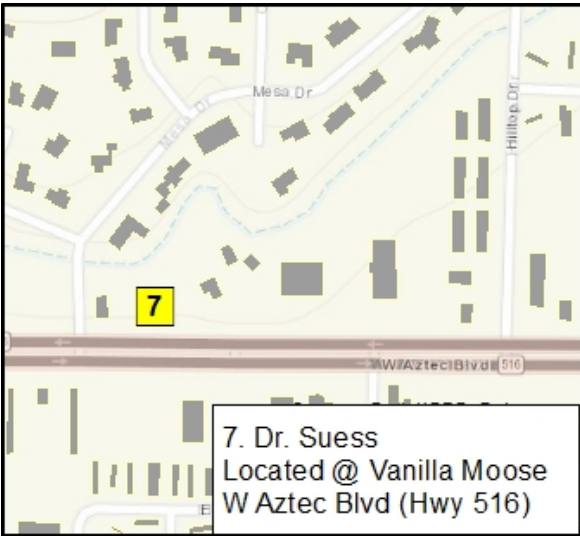


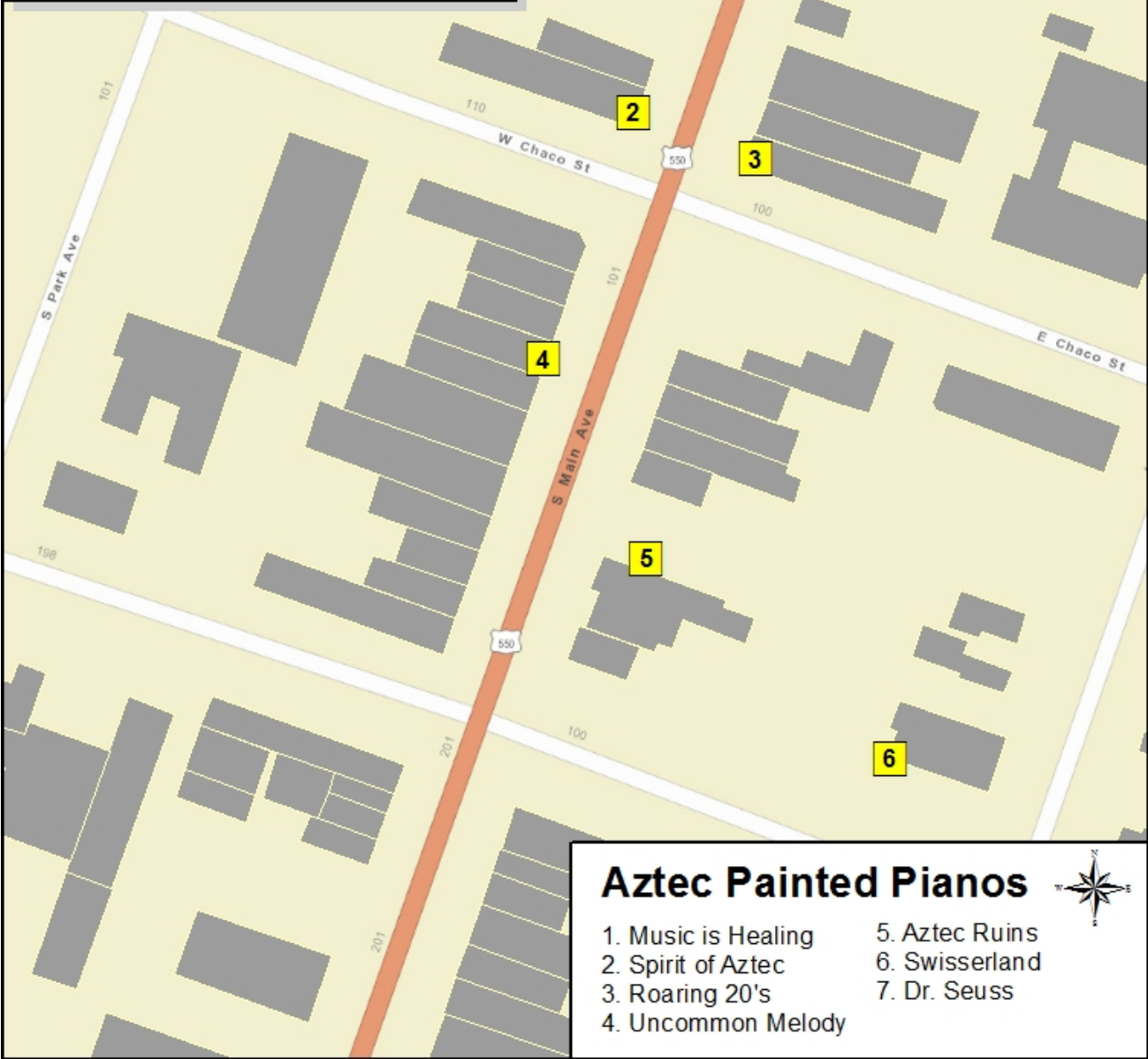
# Big Sound in a Small Town
